Chas. E. Bolch - February 1947

C. E. **Bolch** Passes Away- Well-known Farmer And Business Man Dies

Chas. E. **Bolch**, 72, well-known Iron County successful business man and farmer, passes away on Monday following a major operation a few days ago. He is survived by Mrs. **Bolch**, a daughter, Mrs. George **Giessing** of University City, and a son, Carl, of Florida, and two grandsons.

Mr. **Bolch** was large landowner in Iron County and kept up a lively interest in business, especially his farm in Belleview Valley, even though his health had been bad for several years. He was once connected with the Annapolis Lead Company but sold his interests in it before it got into financial difficulties. He operated a prosperous and large mercantile business in Annapolis. He had befriended many unfortunate and needy in the community in his life-time there. He was born at Iron Mountain January 30, 1875.

Funeral services were held at Annapolis in the Presbyterian Church by Rev. J. G. **West**, of Dexter. Burial was in the Annapolis Cemetery with White and Sons in charge of arrangements
